Streams and Feeds

About 2-3 years ago, I stumbled upon a website, featuring an enormous amount of unprotected surveillance camera streams. You could click through different genres, like „Weather“, „Religion“, „High Quality“ and many more.

The website claims, that these cameras were unprotected, meaning they didn't have a password or they used the default password of the camera, which is easily found online.

This collection of open cameras inspired me to create a series of pieces, which is still growing, called *Streams*. I captured videos from the cameras, and slightly altered and edited them.

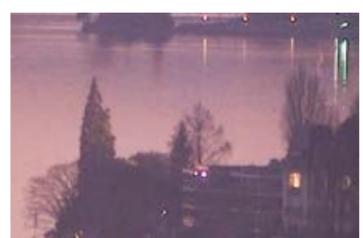
The *Feed* pieces, which are videos I captured with my webcam, are about feeding myself into the system. The two series of works are showing different sides of a voyeuristic worldview.

The *Stream* pieces look outside, without the viewer being there in the flesh. The *Feed* pieces look inside, almost as a mirror. But both views are incomplete, isolated and block real contact with the subject.

The *Stream* and the *Feed* pieces are modular. For every exhibition space, I pick out different pieces from my collection and arrange them anew, so that novel meaning can emerge from in between them.

For every arrangement, there is also a performance associated with it. I will talk about these performances later in the portfolio.

Home, home or home?

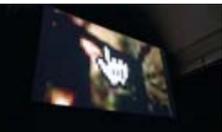
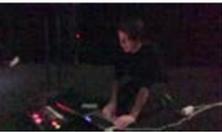
Streams #8, #12, #22 and Feed #4 set the stage for one of my performances. The pieces create an exhibition space, but the presence of my body activates another layer.

In this performance piece I talk about home as a place of residency, as a feeling and as a source of an uneasy, twisted sense of self, through the specter of patriotism.

I tried to connect these far reaching topics through videos of swiss surveillance streams and my body.

The lyrics used in *Feed #4* and my performance are borrowed from a song called „Home“ by Edward Sharpe & The Magnetic Zeros.

scream at the screen*





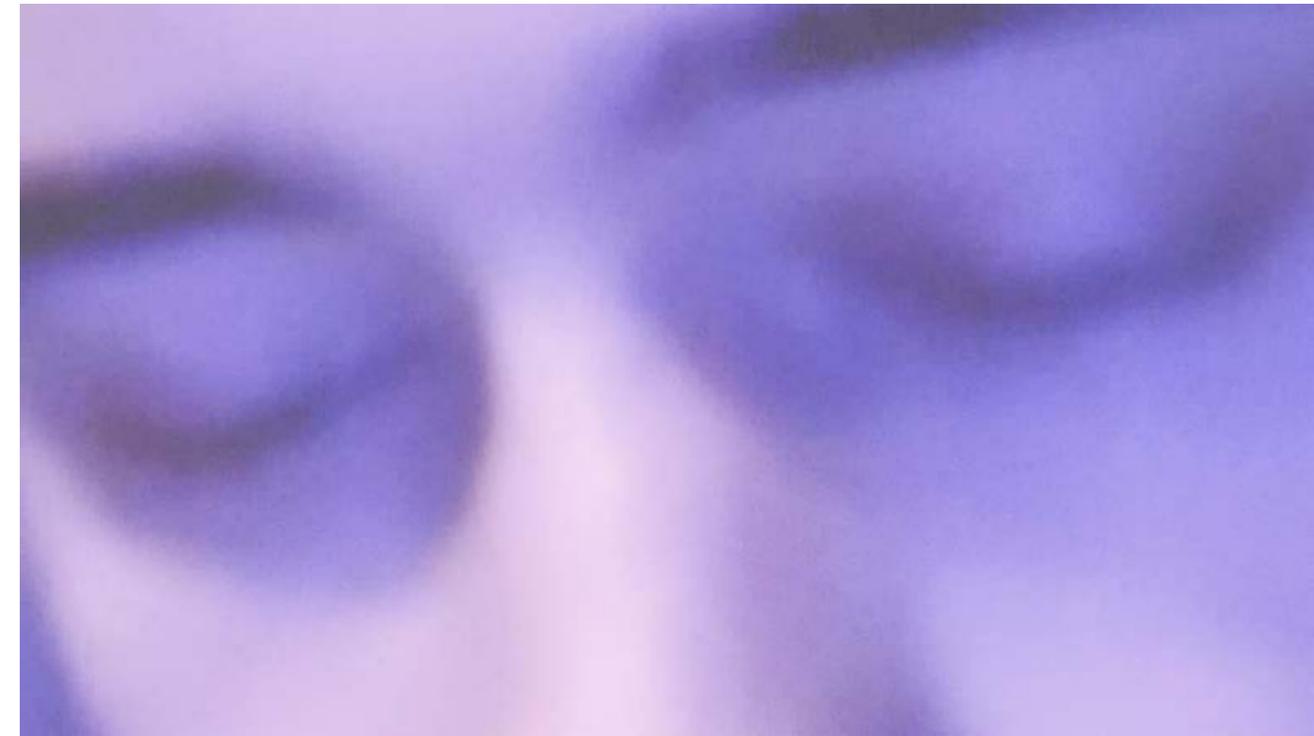

This performance used only one *Feed* piece. *Feed #3 (Bluish)* is a video on a laptop that shows me dancing in my room.

I'm very interested in this in-between. This space between „private“ performance, watched only by an unblinking camera eye, and the public performance. What happens, when something embarrassing and personal is transposed into the open forum? Can people empathize or are they pushed away?

The song I cover in this performance is „*Heart Of Glass*“ by *Blondie*.



Instruments -
Live Audio Manipulation

For a while now, I've been interested in Live Audio Manipulation. Instead of sampling different environmental sounds and arranging them in the studio, I go out and modify and play with them directly. I treat the sound sources as their own instruments.

The first two works were video pieces. To bring back some of the immediacy that was lost in the conversion to video, I realized the later pieces as live performances.

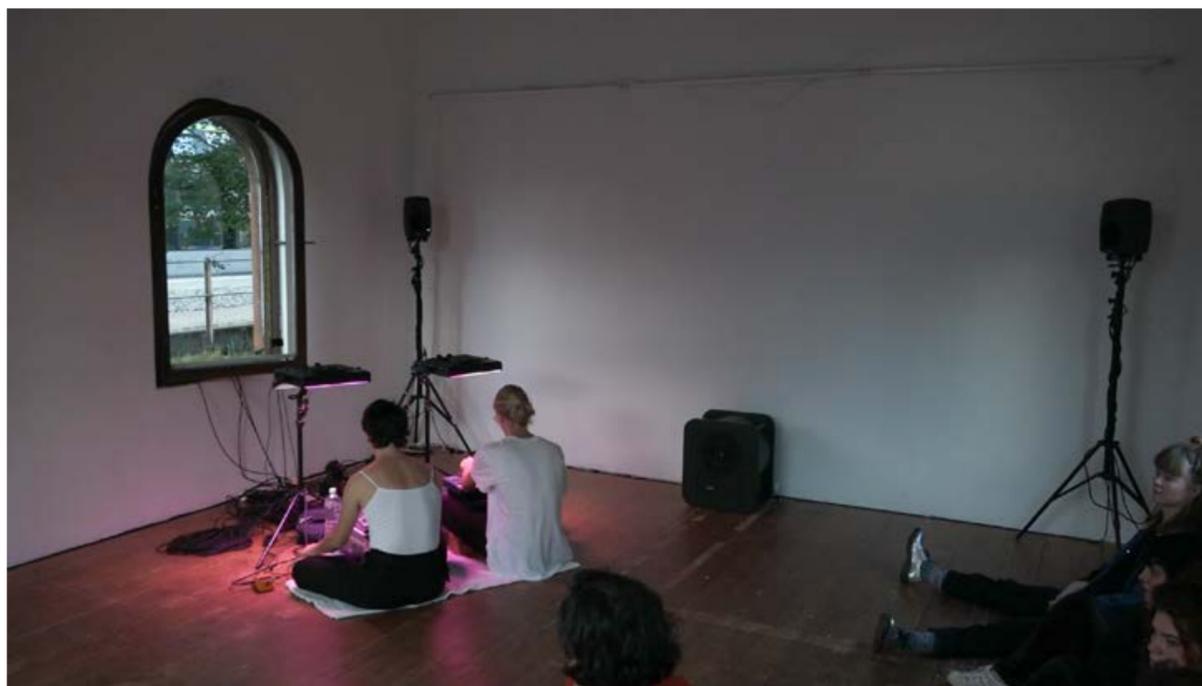


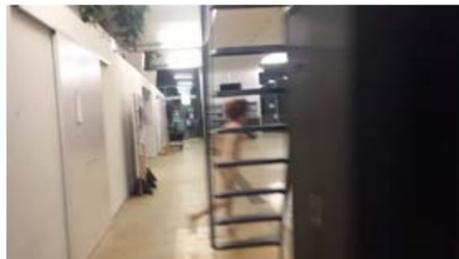
